# GURU NANAK CENTRE *for* RESEARCH

The “Guru Nanak Centre for Research” (GNCR) was initiated in the year 2019 to commemorate the 550<sup>th</sup> birth anniversary of Shri Guru Nanak Devji. It was started in a view to identify and initiate foundational inter – disciplinary and multi-disciplinary research among academicians and researchers and as a Centre for excellence in applied and advanced research.

GNCR is a premier Research Centre with cutting edge knowledge on current research with around 27 Research Supervisors and 80 Research Scholars (both stipendiary and non-stipendiary) from various disciplines such as Commerce, Economics, Defence and Strategic Studies, English, Tamil, Chemistry and Zoology.

The Centre also caters to Independent research through Women Scientists Schemes, JRF and SRF. The Research by GNCR is been recognized by various funding agencies such as UGC, DST, ICSSR and Ministry of Human resource development.

The Humanities and Commerce Research of the Centre focusses on International Economics, Environmental Economics, International Security, Folklore, Modern and Medieval Literature, Banking, Information Technology, Marketing and Human Resource Management. The Centre specializes in Science research in the fields of Fermentation Technology, Green Chemistry, Nano Chemistry, Analytical Chemistry, Crustacean Endocrinology and Immunology. The animal cell culture lab and the Plant tissue culture lab are designed to pioneer studies related to cell line culture and maintenance, cytotoxicity research and algal culture.

The ‘**Student Research Club**’ and the ‘**IPR cell**’ of the College encourages the undergraduate students into active research by providing them a platform to nurture their ideas related to research in all disciplines leading to patent and product development with internal seed funding for research with social relevance. The Data Analytics Lab of the Centre is an exclusive Lab that specializes on data analysis and interpretation both for research leading to Ph.D. as well as for projects.

GNCR hosts researchers across the State through the **Central Instrumentation Facility** to support research in the fields of Biotechnology, Molecular Biology, Microbiology and Genetics. Several National and International patents have been granted to the research work taken up through the Centre.
