**Resource person 1:** Mr. Vaidy Jayaraman, Associate Dean, Great Lakes Institute of Management as the Chief Guest

**Dr. Vaidyanathan Jayaraman**



Dr. Vaidy Jayaraman is a distinguished Chair Professor in the area of Supply Chain Operations, Data Sciences and Analytics. For the past 6+ years, he was also the Principal and Associate Dean (Faculty Affairs and Graduate Program Affairs) at GreatLakes Institute of Management. Prior to joining GreatLakes, he was a tenure senior faculty at the School of Business Administration, University of Miami, Florida where he taught Supply Chain Operations and Analytics. He received his M.S in Mathematical Sciences and his M.B.A in Management from University of Akron, his M.S in Operations Research and his Ph.D in Operations and Supply Chain Management from the Ohio State University, Ohio. In addition to his extensive consulting engagement with several Fortune 100 companies, he has more than 25 years of teaching and research experience and has several years of experience in teaching Executive Education.

He has received numerous awards both in teaching and research and was appointed as a charter member in the University's Faculty Learning Community. He has published more than 100 journal articles and his work in the area of Supply Chains and Service Operations has been heavily cited by both researchers and practitioners. He has close to 11000+ citations of his work and an H-index of 36. He has more than 2 manuscripts that each have been cited more than 100 times by researchers. He is quite passionate about administration and has taken on a leadership role both in the US and in India where he has demonstrated leadership and experience in inspiring colleagues and the ability to work with researchers in other domains of expertise including International Business, Strategy and Marketing. He has co-authored two books and is writing a third book in the area of Supply Chain Analytics and a Fourth in the area of Sustainable Management: Models and Public policy implications.

**Resource person 2:** Mr.S.N.A.Jinnah, Chief General Manager of NABARD, Regional office, Chennai, S.Suresh kumar, Asst.General Manager of Nabard, Trichy and Dr.Jeyaseelan, Group CEO of Hand in Hand India (HiH India) & HIH India team visited a tribal development project implemented by HiH India with the funding support of Nabard at Pachamalai, Tiruchy district.

The main objective of the intervention in this area is to avoid migration of tribal communities and provide them employment all year round in their own villages. The unique strategy used by HiH India for this is titled, “one lakh income from one acre of plantation crop”. Some key changes that HiH India has brought about amongst the farmers in the community include: Training programmes that will allow farmers increase their net income from harvesting tapioca crops by 10 times in 5 years

- Provision of mango (54 plants), cashew (40 plants) and silver oak (80 plants) for farmers
- Introduction of coffee plants in 100 acres
- Training in intercrop cultivation
- Promotion of soil and water conservation measures such as field bunds, stone bunds and farm ponds
- Converting 450 acres of barren lands to cultivable lands

Mr. Kantesh Kumar Singh, chief executive officer COMMUWAY consulting service was a chief guest speaker for the event.

He covered like...

Achieving success through effective business communication typically involves acquiring skills and experience. Learn to express your ideas clearly and succinctly. Take steps to understand your audience. Target your message to meet their needs. Using effective communication helps your message get interpreted correctly. Avoid conflicts with co-workers, managers and customers by using effective communication techniques. Practice using techniques, such as active listening and paraphrasing to ensure your success.

- Analyze your audience before you make a presentation or conduct a meeting. Anticipate possible causes of confusion and prepare clarifying statements. As you prepare, try to see the situation from your audience’s perspective
- Give all the background necessary for people who receive your email, presentation or lecture to take action, such as make a decision based on the information you provide. If your topic requires a comprehensive understanding of complex underlying concepts, state so early in your discussion. Set clear expectations about what you hope your business communication can achieve.
- Keep track of the questions people ask you and learn how to respond to common inquiries. Use active listening techniques, such as paraphrasing what you have heard or nodding in acknowledgment.

- Ask clarifying questions yourself to ensure you truly understand what your audience does not comprehend. Ask open-ended questions to start a conversation, get more details or get input on issues. Ask closed questions that require a simple “yes” or “no” answer to confirm your understanding, get agreement or conclude a meeting.
  - Choose the right communication format for each situation. For example, avoid using email to communicate emotional issues, such as bad news. Use written communication to convey lists of information, such as policies and procedures. Use diagrams and charts to summarize complicated financial data.
  - Proofread your written communication, such as email, reports or other documents. Check for spelling and grammar mistakes so that you fix them before distributing your information. For email messages, include an effective subject line, discuss only one topic and specify the type of response you want.
  - Pay attention to body language when communicating in person. A person who does not look at you or appears distracted in other ways may not be able grasp your message. Use physical cues to tailor your message or know when it might be appropriate to discuss the subject at another time.
  - Defer judgment until the conversation concludes. Avoid interrupting the speaker with counter arguments. It limits your understanding of the situation.
  - Recognize cultural differences in communication styles. Before you work with people from another country, take the time to investigate business practices in that area of the world.

**Day 2 -> Session 2**

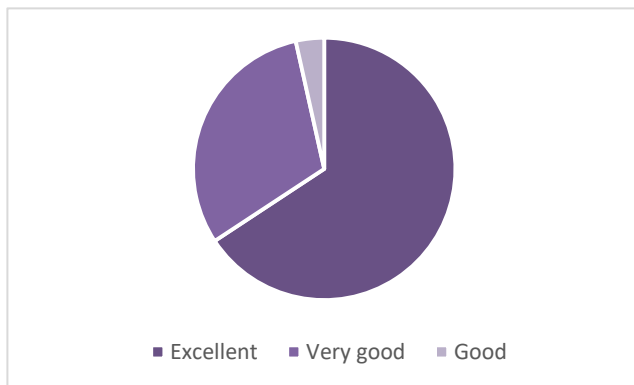

### Report:

To train the students in performing arts and do programs in communities and cultural events. On account of the rural camp to be held at Kalvarayan Hills, Kallakurichi, Villupuram District, The Department of Social Work (MSW) had arranged a workshop for the students of I MSW to learn about and master certain art forms that will help them in forthcoming days at camp and like.

Mr. Arivazhagan convened the workshop by giving a self-introduction about himself and about how he came into the field of performing arts. The students were also asked to give self- introduction about them.

A brief history about arts and different schools of art, how they are important to livelihood of many people and how it is respected and believed to be preserved at any point of time was explained. A trademark of the tradition and culture of Tamil Nadu is well projected through art forms, especially traditional folk dances. Some songs and ragas were taught to be remembered when performing. These art forms are deserved to be preserved and mastered.

The students were taken to the field and divided into 4 sub-groups and dance together according to the ragas that were taught earlier. Each group was allowed to perform separately to bring in team spirit and coordination among the students. There were 10 steps mastered by the students at the end of the day out of 5 in the forenoon session and rest of the 5 in the afternoon session. Recalling of the first set of steps was performed by the student groups

simultaneously according to the beat of the parai, the instructor gave. Post lunch, the students were again divided into different teams and the rest of the steps were taught.

Consolidation of all the steps learnt from the morning were performed by the students in front of the faculties of the department followed by feedback session for the day by the instructor, students' individual experience and by faculties. Students enthusiastically performed out of interest and dedication towards new learnings. Complete concentration was turned towards street theatre.

The session started with an activity for the students to walk in a circle with equal speed and distance in either direction according to the claps of the instructor. This activity was done in order to increase the skills like listening, concentration, perseverance and stress management in certain situations.

The students were taught a song about "Kattiyakaran"- who is the narrator of the story for the street theatre which says the appearance and the reason he had come for. This role briefs the story of the play in short, introduces themselves to the gathering and starts the play with attention seeking, where the whole crowd responds to the clap of the person and coordinates with him to listen to the whole play as the following.

One of the students, Mr. Peter. K.Y from the group was selected as the Narrator and given training about way of talk, walk, body language, expressions etc. to interact with the community.

The street theatre was based on Awareness program to be conducted at kalvarayan hills to tell how wrong and dangerous illegal red sandalwood trafficking is and measures for the people to stop such activities and divert their interest towards other manual works, art forms, etc. to stabilize their livelihood.

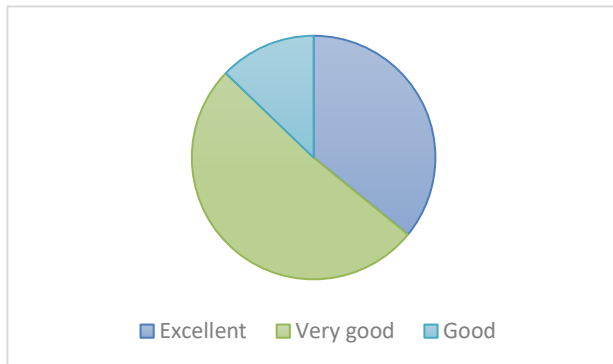




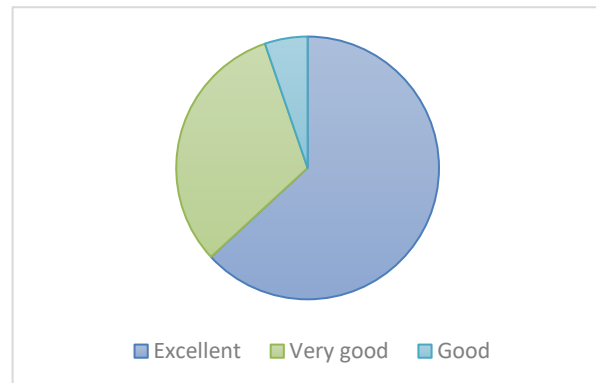
