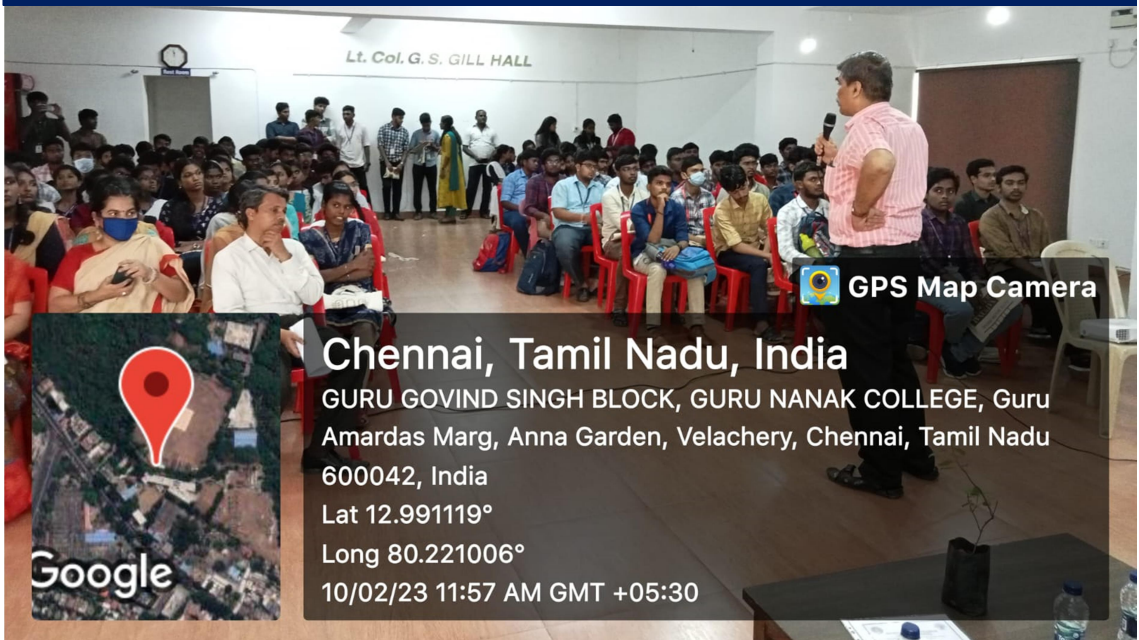

Report

A Sparrow cage awareness programme for creating awareness about inviting of sparrow was organized at the College premises in Assembly square on 11.02.2023. at 10.30 AM. The aim of organizing this awareness programme is taking initiative to save sparrow from extinction and to create awareness about sparrow in the survival of ecosystem.

House sparrows (*Passer domesticus*) are very important to the ecology and play a major role in maintaining the ecological balance. The sparrows play an important role as insect controllers as they eat a phenomenal numbers of insects. Because of the increased anthropological activities and its habitat destruction, its population is reduced and might go extinct, if we aren't start to conserve it. So,we setted up the sparrow cages in our campus to increase the sparrows population and makes its ecological importance valued !!!

Our Principal Sir initiated the event by setting up the first sparrow cage in our campus. The setting up of sparrow cages in a college campus level in the city was first done by us. The students continued to put the food grains in the sparrow cages to attract the sparrows. We are planning to submit the report of the survey of the "sparrows movement in the cages set up in our campus" on the Sparrows day (March 20th). Our initiative mainly focuses on great awareness to the public, as it was put up in the social media and in the news. The Programme was attended by 79 participants (9 Faculty + 70 Students). Initially we are planning to fix 35 sparrow cages in our campus. At present we have fixed 10 sparrow cages in our campus.

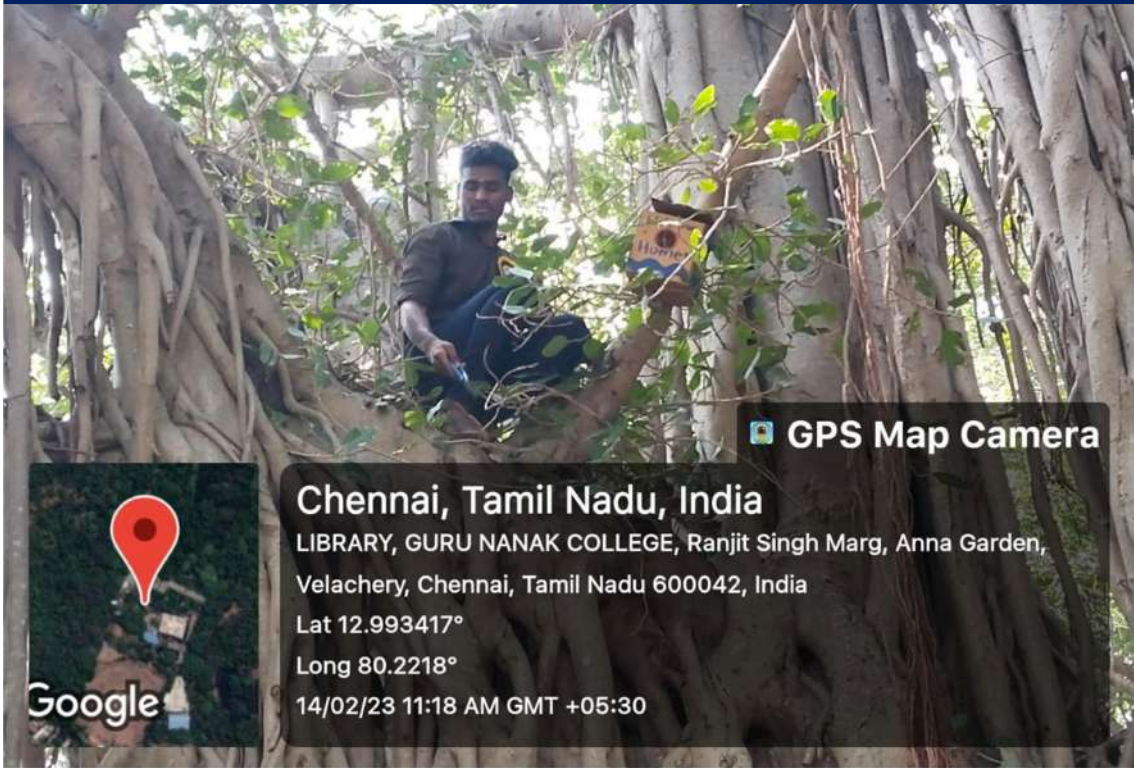

Report

Today students are more connected to modern food style and Fast food lifestyle but less connected to traditional lifestyle. Considering this, Plant Biology and Plant Biotechnology Programme, Organized the Fucshia 2K23 Aarokya mela on 27.02.2023 and insisted on the importance of a conventional lifestyle. The Principal, Dr. M.G. Ragunathan, inaugurated the Aarokya mela. The exhibition displayed 70 varieties of colorful ornamentals and medicinal plants for exhibit cum sale. First-year students explained the therapeutic uses of every plant. Third-year students displayed 14 traditional foods were displayed in the Aarokya mela. The aroma of traditional food was palpable as home-cooked, healthy, and organic dishes were prepared and served. It was an attempt to raise awareness among students about the benefits of millet, organic food, and avoiding junk food.

Notably, 2023 has been declared the International Year of Millets (IYOM 2023) by The United Nations. So to celebrate the initiative, the event also had a food court and stalls, boasting organic and millet-based dishes. Second-year students displayed ten varieties of millets, ten varieties of Cereals, and 34 types of spices and herbal products. The primary purpose of this Aarokya mela is to inculcate the importance of the Traditional lifestyle among Students by teaching them the benefits of Organic and Herbal based foods and the importance of growing plants. The Mela received an overwhelming response. 238 Staff and Students visited the Fucshia 2K23 Aarokya mela.

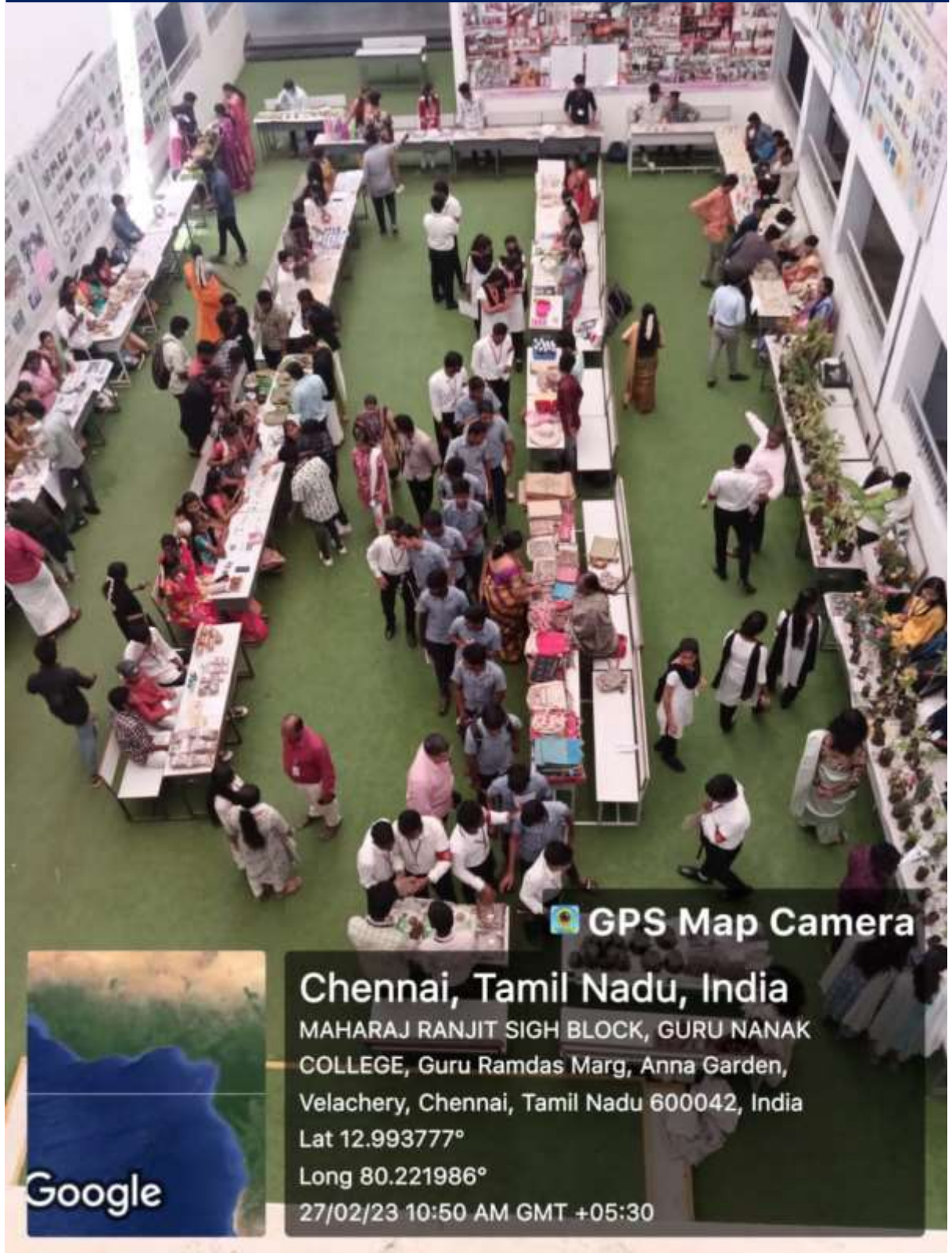
