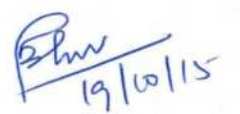
Minutes of the meeting

- The board of studies meeting commenced at sharp 11.00am at the Board Room.
- The chairman formally introduced the Subject experts. All the subject experts unanimously expressed their pleasure over coming here on invitation. They all appreciated the ambience and hospitality extended.
- The rules and regulations for autonomy framed under the Choice Based Credit System with grading pattern are approved for uniform implementation throughout the college.
- Resolved that the first batch of students (2015-18) admitted under the autonomous regulation of the Guru Nanak College, adopt the syllabus framed and approved by the University of Madras for all the six semesters.
- Students admitted from the Academic year 2016-17 onwards shall follow the approved autonomous syllabus.
- The course structure consisting of Part I and II foundation courses, Part III core, Allied and Elective papers, Part IV Non-major Elective/Basic Tamil/Advanced Tamil, skill based elective, Environmental Studies, Value education and Part V extension service with a total of 140 credits is approved.
- The detailed contents of all the UG Physics papers being offered were scrutinized and approved by the committee.
- Mr. R. Chandrakumar the corporate representative explained the need for learning micro controllers using nice presentation
- Each paper was discussed in detail and finally arrived at the following conclusions.
 1. Suggestions were given to include many latest books, journals and websites as reference material.
 2. It was suggested to include "Introduction of micro controller - 8051 "(pin configuration and salient features)
 3. It was decided to delete "Orthogonality properties of Legendre, Hermite and Bessel functions" from unit I of Mathematical Methods in Physics
 4. Apart from additions and deletions, they unanimously advised to have four papers in the final semester for better pass percentage. To ensure four papers in the final semester, two papers namely Solid State Physics and Basic Electronics were merged into a single paper and to be named as "Solid State Physics and Electronics".

Since the unit III "Chemical Bonds and Crystallography" was touched upon in Allied chemistry and the unit V "Magnetic Properties" covered in Electricity and Magnetism were deleted from Solid State Physics paper.

Similarly the II, III and IV unit of Basic electronics were deleted.

5. It was also decided to rearrange the papers for continuity.
 - a) Decided to have Electricity and Magnetism in the IV semester
 - b) Decided to have Electromagnetism and Atomic Physics during the V semester.
 6. The committee members strongly felt that the proposed 50/50 (for internal /external) mark system may not be a healthy practice especially for arts and science colleges. However the passing minimum in internals seems to be a solution for quality.
 7. Members insisted to conduct internship programmes for the pre-final year students during their vacation which could develop their employability skill.
 8. Corrections carried out
 - a) All the reference books suggested were included
 - b) In Elective Paper 3 Microprocessor Fundamentals Unit V was upgraded with "Introduction of micro controller - 8051 (pin configuration and salient features)"
 - c) In Paper 10 Mathematical Methods in Physics the topics "Orthogonality properties of Legendre, Hermite and Bessel functions" were deleted.
- The above changes were carried out in the syllabus and approved by the members of Board of studies.

- The rules and regulations for autonomy framed under the Choice Based Credit System with grading pattern are approved for uniform implementation throughout the college. The evaluation pattern consists of CIA for 50% and ESE for 50%
- Resolved that the first batch of students (2015-18) admitted under the autonomous regulation of the Guru Nanak College, adopt the syllabus framed and approved by the University of Madras for all the six semesters.
- Students admitted from the Academic year 2016-17 onwards shall follow the approved autonomous syllabus.
- The course structure consisting of Part I and II foundation courses, Part III core, allied and Elective papers, Part IV Non-major Elective/Basic Tamil/Advanced Tamil, skill based elective, Environmental Studies, Value education, Extra disciplinary elective- NCC, and Part V extension service with a total of 140 credits is approved.
- Papers offered under Part IV would have only the End Semester Examination for a maximum of 100 marks with no marks for the internal component.
- The syllabi for the extra department papers namely "Physical Education, Health and Yoga" offered by the department of physical education and "Foundation of Library and Information Science" offered by the department of Library and information science were scrutinized and approved.

- The meeting was held on Oct.6, 2015 at 2PM at the Dept. Of Zoology, Guru Nanak College.
- The rules and regulations for autonomy framed under the Choice Based Credit System with grading pattern are approved for uniform implementation throughout the college.
- Resolved that the first batch of students (2015-17) admitted under the autonomous regulation of the Guru Nanak College, adopt the syllabus framed and approved by the University of Madras for all the four semesters.
- Students admitted from 2016 onwards shall follow the approved autonomous syllabus.
- The course structure consisting of core, elective and inter department papers, together with soft skill papers and project work with a total of 90 credits is approved.
- The detailed contents of all the papers being offered were scrutinized and approved by the committee. The following resolutions were adopted and passed:
 1. Resolved that in the M.Sc. Practical Paper – I “**Invertebrata, Chordata & Fishery biology**” the following dissection be deleted a)Nervous system of pila b)Frog-urino-genital, and cranial nerves c) Neck nerves in rat

2. Resolved that in the M.Sc. Practical Paper –II-“**Cell & molecular biology, Biophysics, Biotechnology, Genetics, Biostatistics & Microbiology**” the differential count of blood cells in insects be deleted.
3. Resolved that in the M.Sc. Core Paper IX “**Environmental biology & Evolution**” the topic Environmental impact assessment be added in the unit-III and from the unit- III & IV the laws related to environment & Immunological techniques be deleted.
4. Resolved that in the M.Sc. Core Paper X “**Animal Physiology**”, the topics physiology of hypertonic urine formation, role of pheromones & communication be included.
5. Resolved that in the M.Sc. Practical Paper – III “**Animal Physiology**”, the Effect of insulin and adrenalin in blood glucose level be deleted, the estimation of carbohydrates in the tissues of frog be replaced as estimation of carbohydrates in the tissues of meat and the determination of amino acids in the tissues of frog be replaced as determination of amino acids in the liver/muscle of fish & egg albumin (paper chromatography).
6. Resolved that in the M.Sc. Practical Paper – IV “**Developmental biology**”, the development of chick embryo be replaced as mounting of chick embryo and the observation of live chick embryo using vital stain be deleted.
- The soft skill papers for all PG courses namely Language and communication skills, Spoken and presentation skills, Managerial skills, Computing skills, Quantitative aptitude, Group discussion, Content writing, Basic communication skills, spoken and presentation skills, contemporary awareness were scrutinized and approved.
