





Appendix A General Terms and Conditions of Grant

 Grant. The Grant award (the "Grant Year") was toward the 2020 IBM Volunteer Excellence Award to Gurunanak Educational Society. The award grant to be utilised on or before 31 March 2022.

2. Use of Grant Funds.

- a. No portion of the Grant nor any portion of the interest earned thereon may be used or expended for any other purposes without IBM's prior approval in writing.
- b. Any portion of the Grant not expended or committed (i) for the Purpose, (ii) in substantial accordance with the Budget set forth in Section 3 of this Appendix A, or (iii) within the Grant Period specified above, will be returned promptly to IBM.
- c. No part of the Grant is to be used for the benefit of any other organization without the prior written approval of IBM. Any transfer of any part of the Grant to another organization shall be agreed to in writing by IBM and subject to all conditions and restrictions established by IBM. Grantee will not assign this Agreement to third parties or Affiliates without the prior written consent of IBM. Any unauthorized assignment of this Agreement is void.
- d. No part of the Grant is to be used to carry on propaganda, for the purposes of lobbying, or otherwise attempt to influence legislation. The term "legislation" includes the introduction, enactment, defeat or repeal of any legislation by any legal body, any local township council or similar governing body, and any public referendum, initiative, constitutional amendment or similar procedure.
- e. No part of the Grant is to be used to influence the outcome of any specific public election or to carry on, directly or indirectly, any voter registration drives. Such activities include but are not limited to:
 (i) publishing or distributing printed statements on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate, (ii) paying the salaries and expenses of campaign workers, or (iii) conducting, or paying the expenses of, a voter registration drive.
- f. No part of the Grant shall be used for any purpose other than a charitable, scientific, or educational purpose.
- g. No part of the Grant shall be used to undertake any activity that may directly or indirectly support terrorists or acts of terrorism, or for any other unlawful purpose.
- h. No part of the Grant shall be used to undertake any activity that may directly or indirectly violate, or cause IBM to be in violation of, export controls or sanctions laws, including those of the United States.
- i. Grantee agrees that no individual associated with or employed by Grantee will improperly benefit, whether directly or indirectly, from the Grant.
- 3. Budget. The Grant will be provided substantially in accordance with the following budget (the "Budget"):

The Grant will be provided substantially in accordance with the cash budget set forth in Appendix A (Grant Funds) to this Agreement. The grant payment will be INR 7,45,385.23 upon signing of the agreement by both the parties and receipt of invoice or grant request letter. After the Grant Funds have been released to the Gurunanak Educational Society (Grantee) under the terms hereof and before the Grant Funds are allocated/utilised by Gurunanak Educational Society (Grantee) in accordance with this Agreement, Gurunanak Educational Society(Grantee) shall keep the funds only in [bank accounts in scheduled commercial banks].

4. Segregated Accounts; Books and Records.

- a. The Grant funds shall be held by Grantee in segregated accounts as if in trust for the purposes and on the terms and conditions herein set forth.
- b. Grantee agrees to record in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles all Grant receipts and expenditures in segregated book accounts and maintain detailed records of all Grant receipts and expenditures.
- c. Grantee agrees to retain all books and records of the Grant usage, receipts and expenditures and copies of all reports submitted to IBM for a period of at least six (6) years following termination of this Agreement or completion of all such receipts and expenditures, whichever is later.
- d. Grantee agrees to permit IBM, at its request, or IBM's third-party auditors, to have reasonable access to the Grantee's files, records and personnel relevant to this project for the purpose of making such audits, verifications or program evaluations as it deems necessary concerning the Grant.
- e. Grantee agrees to permit IBM, at its request, to make reasonable field investigations to ensure that all monies are expended in accordance with this Agreement.
- f. Grantee agrees to provide its full cooperation with any such audit, verification, or program evaluation, or field investigation, referenced in this section. For the avoidance of doubt, (i) any books, records and materials contemplated under this section, and (ii) any audit, verification, or program evaluation, or field investigation, contemplated under this section, shall encompass Grantee's compliance with the anti-bribery related provisions in this Agreement.
- 5. Reports. Grantee agrees to provide a financial report to IBM on a weekly/monthly/quarterly basis during the Grant period and an audited final report at the conclusion of the Grant period providing details on the use of the Grant funds. The report shall be provided to IBM within a reasonable period of time after the close of the Grant period. The report shall include a full and complete statement detailing the manner in which the Grant has been used, and a report on Grantee's compliance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement. The report shall be in the form and substance acceptable to IBM and consistent with Grantee's financial reporting systems and generally accepted accounting principles. All statements shall be attested to by a responsible officer of Grantee.

The report shall be provided to IBM within thirty (30) business days of the week/month/quarter or after the expiry of the Grant Period. Any report of the utilisation of the Grant Funds, should include details of interest earned, source of interest earned thereon and utilisation of the interest amount.

The Grantee will also provide a final project report and audited fund utilisation report.

6. Compliance with Laws; Authority. Grantee confirms that the Grantee complies with all applicable city, state and federal laws (including, without limitation, ethics and privacy laws), and the Grant does not conflict with any applicable law, regulation or agency policy. Grantee will be familiar with and will comply with all applicable laws and regulations related to commercial or public sector bribery, corruption, and/or prohibited business practices as it concerns Grantee's activities under or in connection with this



Agreement, including, if and as applicable, the U.S. Foreign Corrupt Practices Act of 1977. Grantee has obtained all necessary approvals and authorizations to accept the Grant.

- 7. Certification/Notification. Upon written request from IBM, Grantee will certify compliance with the anti-bribery obligations set forth under this Agreement. Grantee shall promptly notify IBM, to the extent permitted by applicable law or regulation, if Grantee should learn that a violation of the anti-bribery provisions has occurred as it concerns Grantee's activities under this Agreement. It is understood that any such disclosure will not include attorney-client or other privileged materials, confidential information or information protected from disclosure by applicable law, regulation or governmental authority.
- 8. **Grantee's Charitable Status**. Grantee shall not take any action, or fail to take any action, that it might reasonably be expected to know would, or could with the passing of time, have a material adverse effect on the tax-exempt status of the Grant. The foregoing restriction shall apply whether or not such action or inaction is contemplated herein.
- 9. **Remedies**. If Grantee violates or is likely to violate any of the agreements and conditions set forth herein, in addition to those remedies provided by applicable law:
 - a. IBM shall have the right to immediately terminate this Agreement.
 - b. IBM shall have the right to retain any undistributed funds with no further obligation to distribute funds; and
 - c. IBM shall have the right for reimbursement from Grantee for any money spent outside of the authority granted to this Agreement and its appendices.

The rights and remedies set forth herein are not exhaustive and shall be cumulative. Exercise by IBM of one such remedy shall not preclude exercise by it of the other remedies set forth herein and/or other remedies available to IBM in law or equity.

- 10. **Undistributed Funds; Right of Reimbursement**. REPORT

Guru Nanak College (Autonomous) of Chennai conducted a NAAC sponsored National Conference on "Strategies for Quality Enhancement in Higher Education" –SQEHE 2016 on 15th and 16th of July 2016. Dr. M. Selvaraj, Principal emphasized on that teachers need to develop professionalism in their career and there should be increments and incentives on the basis of the performance of a teacher. Dr. A. Karthikeyani. Convener of the conference and IQAC coordinator, while briefing the theme of the conference insisted on the need for quality enhancement in the Higher Education in the present scenario of globalization. Dr. Gunita Arun Chandok Director, Shift II delivered the vote of thanks." International reputed speakers from academia and administrative bodies working at the helm of National planning in higher education addressed the gathering of 300 participants consisting of college professors of the city and other places.

The thrust area being quality education, the speakers spread over a wide spectrum of higher education and recommended a series of strategies for enhancing the quality in higher education. The talks were based on their experiences of two decades and more with practical utility. Mr. P.Murari, I.A.S., Advisor to President- FICCI & Former Secretary to the President of India, in his inaugural address, emphasized that "Education and Employment should match and Colleges should work hand in hand with the Industry". In the key note address Dr. A. Gnanam, Founder Director, NAAC, and Vice-Chancellor for Bharathidasan University, Madras University and Pondicherry University stressed that "teachers need to follow the high quality of teaching adopted in reputed global Institutions."

Dr.Varghese, Director, Centre for Planning and Research in Higher Education (CPRHE), National University of Education Planning and Administration (NUEPA) presented a critical view of the different dimensions of globalization in higher education. He drew a balance sheet of the impact of globalization on India and suggested that in Indian universities and colleges must set up campus branches in collaboration with leading institutions of the western countries.

The core note was struck by Prof.S.Selvam, Prof. of Eminence at IIT Delhi and Managing Director, National Institute for Professional Excellence who gave practical tips on "Education, Research and innovation". Dr.S.Pragadesswaran, Prof. Dept. of Management Studies, Annamalai University, Chidambaram, Spoke on "Modernization of Higher Education by moralization of Young minds in Yogic Practice".

In the valedictory address, **Dr. Sivasubramaniam**, **Advisor**, **R & D**, **Vel's University and former Vice-Chancellor**, **Bharadhiyar University**, exhorted to the staff to adopt new methods and new technologies indealing with the students. They must look beyond the box and must work out of the box. **Dr.Thangaraj**, **former Vice-Chancellor**, **Periyar University**, drew attention of the psychological aspects of the students and urged the teachers to be more student friendly in their behaviour and communication with the students. Dr. Karthikeyani, Convener of the conference summed up that it is only in the hands of the teachers, educationists and administrators who can enhance the quality in Higher Education. Further, she added that "this conference has worked as an instrument of ignition for the participants of 300 faculty members which will be a lead in the quality enhancement".


