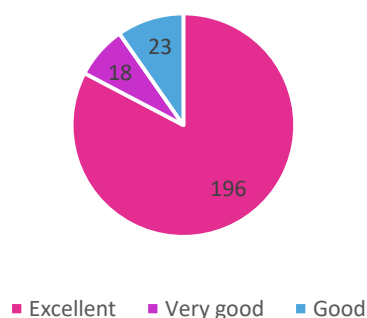
Resource person
