#### **REPORT**

Adding a touch of innovation into environmentalism, a group of 'green soldiers' have taken up an awareness campaign with the unique idea of preparing seed balls. As many as 15733 seed balls were prepared on the grounds of Guru Nanak College Campus on 21.09.2019 by students of PBPBT, AZBT, Enviroclub, NSS, NCC and NGOs volunteers for scattering in the countryside as part of their extension activity. The Event was inaugurated by college President Sardar Rajinder Singh Bhasin in the presence of Principal Dr. M.G. Ragunathan and Enviroclub Coordinators Dr. M. Gopi and Dr. S.S. Jayaraj. Dr. M.G. Ragunathan, Principal highlighted the importance of seed balls in natural farming technique which contains plant potential for an entire ecosystem. This event was held jointly by Vidiyal Charitable Trust, Rudambara Yoga trust, Annakkili Ammal Research Institute and Sevalayam NGOs.

The event introduced this ancient concept of 'seed balls' to a group of students, who learnt the methods and preparation of compost for the seed balls. Seed balls, also known as 'earth balls', consist of a variety of different seeds rolled within a ball of clay with compost and soil.

Experts say the success rate of saplings born out of seed balls tends to be high. "The seed balls are an ancient technique for propagating plants from seeds without opening up soil with cultivation tools such as a plough. This technique is used to introduce vegetation to the land by throwing or dropping seed balls by aerial reforestation.

The students sat around mounds of mixture of red soil, clay and vermi compost to make balls inserting Pungan, Vembu, Poovarasu, Eyalvaagai, Yaanaigundumani, Sarakondrai and other seeds of native species that the students had themselves collected from various parts of the district.

Increasing green cover, enlarging diversity of flora, extending size of forests, ensuring regularity of monsoons and according thrust on farming and restoration of natural resources constituted the objectives of the exercise involving a few hundred students.

Students were instructed to disperse the seed balls in their villages to make them soak in wet soil after a spell of rain during the monsoon season. Hostel students going home for weekends by buses and trains were told to disperse the seed balls en route.

Seed balls will be made in subsequent phases with the remaining stock. The Event ignited the young minds to develop an eco-friendly environment and awareness about conservation of forest among students. The Event also witnessed participation from the public and it was a grand success.

#### **REPORT**

The aim of the campaign was to clean the litter around the Velachery lake and water bodies in general, elimination of water hyacinth weed and to bring the issue to the public's attention through concrete activities.

The activity also intended to inspire people to clean up beaches on a voluntary basis. In addition to motivating individuals, the intent was to motivate different kinds of clubs, hobby groups, businesses, institutions and residents' associations, school children and students, families and groups of friends, and other organizations.

#### History of Velachery lake:

Velachery *aeri* or Velachery lake, is one of the lakes inside Chennai, in the Indian state of Tamil Nadu, with a good stock of water all through the year. Since Velachery is a low-lying area, the monsoon rain water from the neighbouring areas is drained into this lake. In an unexpected turn of events, the Chennai Corporation decided to put on hold the proposal for boat rides and other tourist facilities on the Velachery lake, one of the few water bodies still alive in the city. The reason it cited was the high level of contamination of the water.

"The water is totally contaminated and not conducive for boating. At present, storm water drain works are in progress near the lake, which we hope will put an end to illegal discharge of sewage from residential areas. So we have targeted to help the NGO to clean the lake.

The Association aims to provide guidance on environmentally conscious ways to get around on cleaning of waterways. This activities are not funded and is volunteers based activity.

We actively advise all those tress passer in and around the waterways ways to enjoy the natural surroundings in an environmentally-friendly manner.

The objective is to advise everyone on ways to navigate the waters in an environmentallyconsiderate and respectful way.

The 2 Project staff and project group of 15 students started their campaign from 10.07.2019 to 20.07.2019. Initially 15 students led the campaign on part time basis. At present the campaign on volunteering basis has reached 52 volunteers.

In addition to cleaning up the lake, these voluntary work events also aim to gather information about the type of litter found and types of plant in the lake. GNC EC (GNC Enviro club) has asked the teams of volunteers to report the type of litter material on the litter form created for the campaign. The reports can be returned to the campaign head by post or e-mail, or via the online form. The campaign will work throughout the year to clean the lake periodically.

The support has come mainly in the form of encouragement from the Principal and students of Guru Nanak colleges .This kind of support was very important, especially in the first year, when the campaign was being launched.
