To provide much needed assistance in view of the growing demand for oxygen beds and medical care in Chennai, a 16- bed Covid Care Centre was set up at the Sports Pavilion Building of the Guru Nanak College Campus on May 30, 2021. All the beds have been provided with a piped line oxygen facility with 10 LPM oxygen concentrators. Individual steam inhalers have been provided. ECG facility and also all basic medicines were procured. The wards have been neatly conducted and the entire facility is air-conditioned. All this was made possible by the support of well-wishers of the GNES, who were always a source of strength during any of the Society's social initiatives. A special mention with gratitude that 10 Lpm Oxygen Concentrators have been provided by the government of Tamil Nadu. REPORT

On March 30, 2020, barely five days after the nationwide lockdown had been announced, the Guru Nanak College relief camp was up and running and received the guest workers, thus becoming the first college in the state, if not the country, to start this much-needed facility as hundreds of millions of migrant workers had been caught totally by surprise due to the lockdown and shutting of their workplace. At the Guru Nanak College relief camp, around 400 guest workers and 100 volunteers were provided comfortable and clean facilities to stay, given nutritious food, provided health screening, with daily yoga and exercise sessions conducted. Besides this, they were also provided with bed sheets, t-shirts, toiletries and footwear. All these activities strictly adhered to social distancing and the hygiene norms laid down by the authorities. The camp was operated for a period of 45 days as the initial 21-day lockdown was repeatedly extended and the guest workers could not leave for their homes until the train services resumed.

Several classrooms were converted into residential areas for the migrant workers, maintaining the social distancing norms. Every day they were served tea in the morning followed by breakfast. Sumptuous lunch and dinner, prepared in the most hygienic manner, was served to them. To keep them healthy and fit, both mentally and physically, daily meditation, yoga and zumba sessions were conducted on the college grounds. To keep them entertained, movies were also screened in the assembly square during the night. Doctors and healthcare workers were arranged for and periodical tests were conducted for migrant workers to ensure their good health.

The migrants were so impressed and thanked the whole team for taking such good care of them during this stressful time. When the government permitted them to travel to their hometown, food was packed for everyone, buses were arranged and they bid a very emotional and grateful adieu to the GNES team. Besides

organising a dedicated and unique migrant rescue camp, the GNES team also prepared and sent food for another batch of 200 guest workers residing in nearby shelters. Every day, thrice a day for 45 days, entirely on its own internal resources. The camp was supported and visited by various Governing Council members, several service organisations and individual donors, who also provided voluntary services, donations in the form of food, groceries, essentials and monetary assistance.
