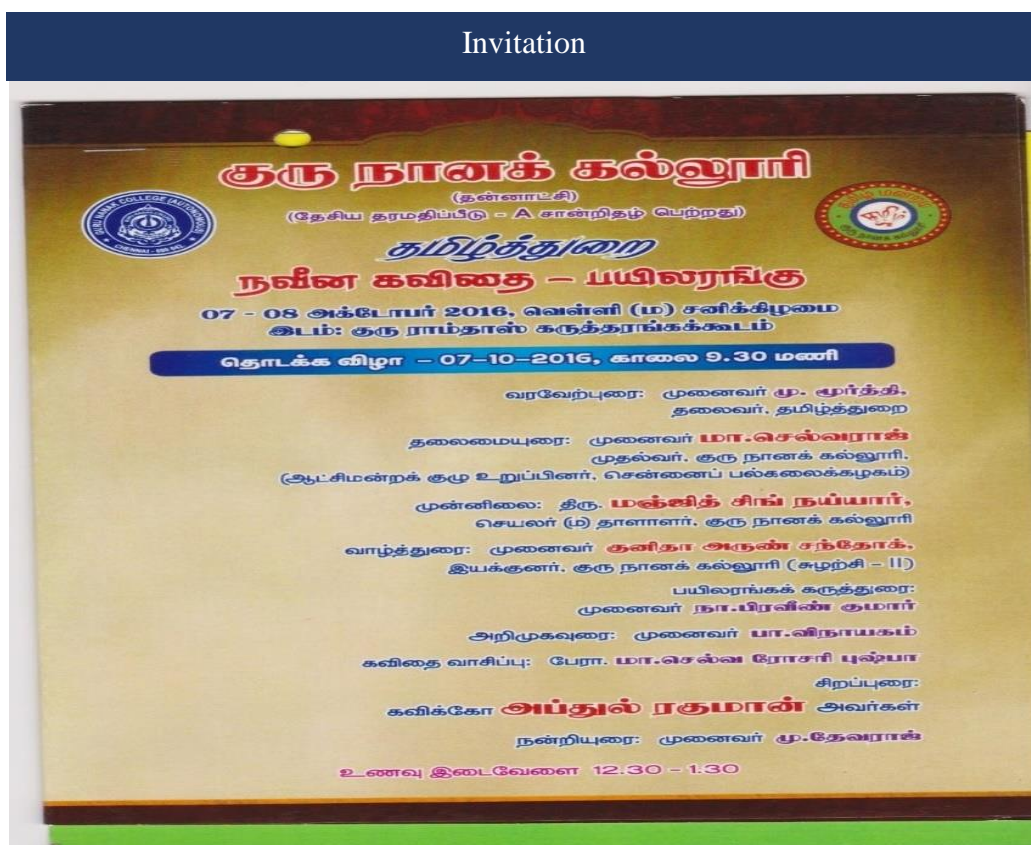


2.3 MODERN POETRY
