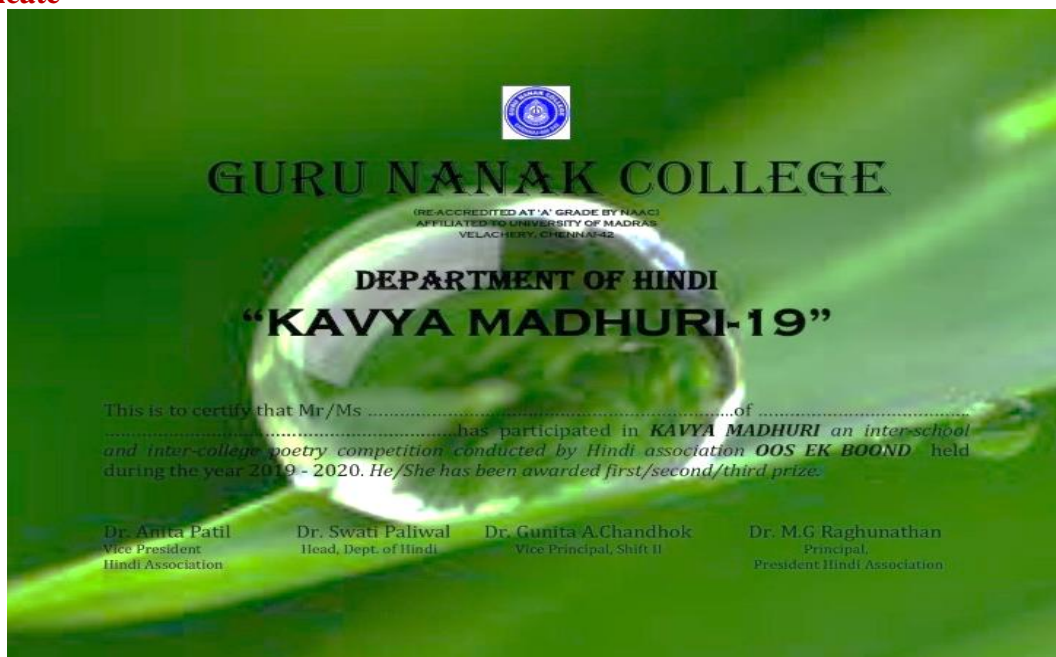
### Report
