Eligibility for Admission

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants for the degree courses should have passed the Higher Secondary Examination (Standard XII under the 10 plus 2 pattern prevalent in Tamil Nadu or its equivalent from other boards)

Candidates who pass the All India Senior School Certificate Examinations, New Delhi, will be eligible for admission, provided they pass the examination with a minimum of five subjects of which English shall be compulsory. An applicant should produce an eligibility certificate, from the University of Madras, at the time of interview

English is the medium of instruction for all courses of study. Tamil, Hindi, Sanskrit & French are offered under Part I. All courses are under the semester pattern, affliated to the University of Madras

ADMISSION

An applicant provisionally selected for admission will be called for an interview with the Principal. His/her parent or guardian should be present at the time of interview. A call for interview does not necessarily ensure admission. At the time of interview, the candidate should produce all the relevant certificates in original as mentioned in the interview card for verification.

Foreign students should produce a regular, long-term student visa issued by the Indian Embassy. All admissions are provisional and are subject to the approval of the University of Madras. Every selected student should follow the code of conduct prescribed by the College and the Government.

APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

Students who wish to obtain admission should apply in the prescribed form, which can be obtained from the College.

Application forms may also be filled online; visit gurunanakcollege.edu.in for details.

The last date for receipt of filled-in application forms for UG Courses: the 10th day after the publication of the Higher Secondary School Examination results of Government of Tamil Nadu and, for the PG Courses: the 10th day after the publication of B.A./B.Sc./ B.Com. results of the University of Madras.

Rules and Regulations

ATTENDANCE

Seventy five percentage of attendance is mandatory for the students to appear for the examination. However it is recommended that the students put in 100% attendance for all the lecture classes and practicals in their own interest and for their benefit.

ANTI-RAGGING

Ragging in any form in any place or time will be deemed a serious offence that will warrant severe punishment including summary expulsion from the college. In this regard, the special Secretary to Government of Tamil Nadu, Chennai 600 009 has issued a Notification under the Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1997.

CELL PHONES

Students are not permitted to use cell phones in college campus. Violation of this rule will result in confiscation of the phone.

DRESS CODE

Though the College does not prescribe any uniform other than the Lab coats, the students are expected to dress in a modest way. T-shirts with printed wordings on them and without collars are not permitted for male students. Female students have to wear salwar kameez with dupatta, no sleeveless or transparent clothing is permitted in campus. Students are expected to make themselves presentable when inside the campus.

STRICTLY NO DONATIONS

Parents and guardians are informed that the College has a policy not to accept donations for admission directly or indirectly. Any malpractice in this regard may be brought to the notice of the Principal immediately.

FEES

The College collects very nominal fees affordable to the ordinary citizens of our Country.

Students who leave mid-way through the course should pay the fees for the entire course. No request for refund of fees will be entertained.
