About the College

Guru Nanak College was established in the year 1971 to mark the 500th Birth Anniversary of Guru Nanak Devji, founder of the Sikh religion. The college is a full fledged co-educational, post graduate and research institution. It is located in a sprawling area of 25 acres of land in Velachery Main Road in South Chennai, Tamil Nadu.

To meet the growing demand for admission to the institution, to introduce innovative courses and to make optimum use of infrastructural facilities available, Shift II was started in 1981. The overall students'-strength at present is 5800. True to its motto, Pro Bono Publico – "for the benefit of all" the college provides quality education to all irrespective of caste, creed, gender and community.

Highlights

In 2013, the college was re-accredited at "A Grade" by NAAC.

The College has been ranked among the top 50 colleges in India, according to a survey conducted by the esteemed National Magazines, "India Today" and "The Week" in 2015.

A Language lab with 1000 hour modules was installed in 30 computers on campus. This has become functional from February 2017. The faculty of English who were trained by 'Educorp' has been able to impart excellent communication skills in English to students across the various disciplines.

Sixteen certificate courses were introduced from 2017.

Gurushiksha – an interschool and inter collegiate competition is conducted every year to spread the ideas and teachings of the Sikh Gurus.

Eligibility for Admission:

Applicants for the degree courses should have passed the higher secondary examination (XII Standard) undr the 10 plus 2 pattern prevalent in Tamil Nadu or its equivalent from other University of Boards.

Candidate who pass the All India Senior school certificate Examinations, New Delhi, will be eligible for admission, provided they pass the examination with a minimum of five subjects of which English shall be compulsory. An applicant should produce an eligibility certificate, from the University of Madras, at the time of Interview.

English is the medium of instruction for all the courses of study. Tamil, Hindi, Sanskrit, and French are offered under first language. All courses are under the semester pattern, affiliated to the University of Madras.

Admission

An application provisionally selected for admission will be called for an interview with the Principal. The parent or guardian should be present at the time of interview. A call for interview does not necessarily ensure admission. At the time of interview the candidate should produce all the relevant certificates in original as mentioned in the interview card for verification.

Foreign student should produce a regular, lon-term student visa issued by Indian Embassy. All admission are provisional and are subject to the approval of University of Madras. Every selected student should follow the code of conduct prescribed by the College and the Government.

Student who wish to obtain admission should apply in the prescribed form, which can be obtained from the College. Application forms may also be filled in online. Rules & Regulations Attendance

Seventy five percentage of attendance is mandatory for the students to appear for the examination. However it is recommended that the students put in 100% attendance for all the lecture classes and practicals in their own interest and for their benefit.

Students are not permitted to use cell phones in college campus. Violation of this rule will result in confiscation of the phone.

Dress Code

Though the College does not prescribe any uniform other than the Lab coats, the students are expected to dress in a modest way. T-shirts with printed wordings on them and without collars are not permitted for male students. Female students have to wear salwar kameez with dupatta, no sleeveless or transparent clothing is permitted in campus. Students are expected to make themselves presentable when inside the campus.
