The College imparts holistic and value-based education to all students irrespective of nationality, caste, creed, socio-economic or religious background. The College follows the reservation policy prescribed by the Govt. of Tamil Nadu.

Programmes / Courses of Study

GNC offers 23 Undergraduate, 9 Postgraduate and 26 Certificate courses in the regular stream.

Research leading to Ph.D. Degree is offered in 7 disciplines and M.Phil. Degree course is offered in the faculties of Zoology and Economics.

The academic courses adopt Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) with a prescribed minimum of 140 credits for an Undergraduate degree and 90 credits for a Postgraduate degree under the semester pattern. The college conducts a Bridge Course in English for all freshers, to improve their communication skills. Additionally, classes in computing skills are provided to them as the college administration is wholly technology based, with the assistance of an in-house developed 'Integrated Management System (IMS). Further, skill training is imparted through the Guru Nanak Centre for Skill Development. For the final year students, preplacement training and placement assistance is provided.

Education at GNC focuses on moulding the students into socially conscious citizens of tomorrow and hence, they are encouraged to participate in extensive co-curricular and extra-curricular activities organized by the college.



Schools of Academic Excellence

Guru Nanak College introduced the School System in January 2020 with the objective of development of qualitative academic curriculum and to foster inter-disciplinary and multi-disciplinary studies. Inter-disciplinary knowledge helps students in consolidating their learning by synthesizing ideas from varied perspectives; acquire alternate skill sets, leading to critical, creative and practical thinking. Six Schools of Excellence comprising Languages, Humanities, Sciences, Commerce, Management Studies, and Information Technology have been introduced. Admission

The applications to all courses are to be submitted only On-line. The last date for submitting applications for the UG Courses is the 10th day from the publication of the +2 results of the Tamil Nadu State. For PG Courses it shall be 10th day from the publication of UG results of the Madras University. All candidates will be selected on the basis of merit only. The selected candidates will be intimated by a message to the mobile number and e-mail provided by the candidate, for the certificate verification, personal interview and admission. Fees has to be paid on admission and Identity Cards will be issued on the day of admission. Rules and Regulations

Attendance

Seventy five percentage of attendance is mandatory for the students to appear for the examination. However it is recommended that the students put in 100% attendance for all the lecture classes and practicals in their own interest and for their benefit. Marks for regular attendance forms a component of Internal Assessment.

Anti-Ragging

Ragging in any form in any place or time will be deemed a serious offence that will warrant severe punishment including expulsion from the college. In this regard, the special Secretary to Government of Tamil Nadu, Chennai-600009 has issued a notification under the Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1997. Compliance of the same is strictly enforced.

Fees

The College collects very nominal fees affordable to the ordinary citizens of our Country. Students who leave mid-way through the course should pay the fees for the entire course. Fees shall be paid online. No request for refund of fees will be entertained.

Centres of Excellence

Guru Nanak Centre for Research (GNCR)

GNCR is a premier Research Centre with cutting edge knowledge on current research with around 26 Research Supervisors from various disciplines such Commerce, Economics, Defence and Strategic Studies, English, Corporate Secretaryship, Zoology, Chemistry, Tamil and an exclusive research on Insect – Plant interaction by G.S.Gill Research Institute. GNCR has around 121 Research Scholars who are involved in active research.

GNCR aims to disseminate knowledge among the academicians involved in research and to successfully transform these findings into applied and advanced research. It functions as a centralized platform to identify and initiate foundational inter–disciplinary and multi-disciplinary research and also as a Centre for excellence in applied and advanced research. Apart from indigenous research GNCR also conducts outreach programmes with social relevance. Several lab equipments are available and a Data Analytics Centre is also attached for the purpose of research.

Guru Nanak Centre for Skill Development (GNCSD)

GNCSD focuses on the employability skills that will facilitate the students to compete in the global job market. The Centre has associated with various government agencies such as MSME, KVIC, ICT Academy, MMA and NSIC and provides skill training classes for all students of the college. In these days of the pandemic, it is also essential to motivate students towards entrepreneurship. Towards this goal, efforts are also taken up for training and providing project financing assistance. During the last year around 2000 students were trained by MSME in Tally 9.0, Computer hardware, CCTV installation, Solar panel design, and Mobile phone servicing and repair. With expertise from KVIC, students were trained in Bakery products making, Costume jewellery making, Canning and food preservation, Preparing herbal products and Preparation of simple chemicals. All candidates were provided with government certification. The establishment of a MSME Facilitation Centre, as a social outreach initiative is on the anvil.

Industrial Visits

They are also encouraged to visit different stores to get to know about different store formats, layouts, merchandising and aesthetics.

Corporate Interventions

Frequent corporate intervention is made available for the students to get trained incorporate requirements, identification of skills needed and they are trained to be corporate ready. Course structure

They also provide IT maintenance support services.

Symposia / Workshops and Seminars in Coordination with Industry

Department of MCA conducts periodic seminar and workshop in coordination with the industry experts. A 150-hour workshop was conducted for cloud infrastructure and soft skill training including AWS cloud platform training in coordination with ICT Academy and Tamil Nadu Skill Development Corporation (TNSDC). Some of the topics that were selected for the workshops are Artificial Intelligence using Python, Machine Learning with R, Data Science and Analytics training programs that help the students to secure high score in International Certification. This helps them to get placements with top companies. We invite expatriates to provide the real time requirements of the global clients in the field of Information Technology. Data Software Research Company (DSRC) has deployed their training portal to train our MCA students in the Relational Data Base Technologies.

Intercollegiate Technical symposiums are conducted periodically that can help the students to find their strength and weaknesses. Cloud Literacy is given to all the students and this has helped them understand and learn the cloud platform.

Twinning & Distance Education Programme

The demand for College admissions is very high. The GNC receives around 22,000 applications for the various undergraduate and post-graduate programmes every year; while the College is able to accommodate only 2000 candidates in the regular programmes. Hence, the Guru Nanak Educational Society has inked an MOU with the Pondicherry University - A Central University under which the College is offering MBA (Finance, Marketing, HR), M.Com., M.A. Sociology, M.A. Hindi, B.Com and BBA Courses under the Twinning programme and Distance mode. This will be a boon to the people who are employed. housewives and the students who could not obtain admission in the regular mode. The results of MBA Twinning Programme is 82%, for the academic year 2019-2020.

Student Support Services

The economically backward students are also supported by Scholarships from the Government (State & Central), private agencies, alumni and the Management. The management provides tuition fee waiver for the children of the staff, Sikh students and other deserving students. There is a Gurudwara with a Langar kitchen on the Campus. The Priest leads the weekly prayer at the General Assembly of staff and students. The Langar kitchen facilitates the serving of free food to the needy students every working day.

Swabodhini - School for Special Children

Swabodhini - School for Special Children and Vocational center caters to children with autism, intellectual disabilities and associated challenges, aged 4 to 30. Swabodhini imparts special education, occupational therapy, speech therapy, yoga and vocational training to the students, depending on their functional ability and age. Training in vocational skills prepares students to be mainstreamed into society or to be trained for supported employment. The 12 months vocational skill training courses, in the domains of Computer/ Admin skills, Retail Skills and Culinary Skills, have been Accredited by Guru Nanak College (Autonomous) and the students receive certification from the college. Swabodhini replicates its model at Thiruvanmiyur in the Guru Nanak College campus. This Inclusion, the first of its kind, has brought about remarkable progress, in the students with special needs. Two students have been offered employment in the college office, for a life of dignity. The College students have also benefited by reaching out to these children, with the ethical values, imparted by Guru Nanak College.

Guest workers Relief Camp for the Covid 19 Pandemic

As part of the Institution Social Responsibility, the Guru Nanak Educational Society in association with the Tamil Nadu Home guards readily offered to conduct a relief camp, in the College campus, for guest workers during the lockdown period to contain the Covid-19 pandemic. Around 400 guest workers (mainly from Odisha) and 100 volunteers were provided accommodation, nutritious food, bed-sheets, toiletries, health screening, yoga and exercise sessions, adhering to social distancing and all hygiene norms laid down by the authorities. Mr.Manjit Singh Nayar, the College Gen. Secretary & Correspondent is also the Asst. Commandant General TN Home Guards and hence the organization of the camp was of high standards. The camp was supported and visited by several service organizations and individual donors in terms of service, food materials, essentials and monetary assistance. Highranking officials including the Director General of Police, Commissioner of Police, ADGP (Home guards), Commissioner (Corporation of Madras), IAS and IPS officers and other senior officials visited the camp regularly. On hearing the details of this unique relief camp, the Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu Shri Edappadi K. Palaniswami, visited the camp in person, participated in the distribution of food and addressed the camp volunteers and the guest workers. He also held a press meet at the College Campus on the management of covid relief camps, at the conclusion of his visit. The Leader of the Opposition also visited the camp and provided large quantities of relief materials, including masks, bread, groceries and vegetables to the camp. At the conclusion of the Camp elaborate arrangements were also made for their smooth return by train to their home state of Odisha. This was a model camp and the great service rendered by the College was accorded wide appreciation from various quarters.
